


City Rules for Owning a Dog

Dog Registration

- Registration is required for dogs 3 months old or older.
- Registration fee is 3,000 yen.
- Registration is done once and valid for the dog's lifetime.
- A Rabies Vaccination Certificate is required starting from March 2 of the year your dog is registered.
- If you have registered your dog in a different city and moved to Yokosuka, you must complete procedures at the Animal Protection Center (*Dobutsu Aigo Center*). Bring the dog tag. No fees required.
- If you have registered your dog in Yokosuka and are moving out to a different city, please complete the moving-in procedures at the local government office of your new residence.



Rabies Vaccination

- Please have your dog vaccinated against the rabies every year from April 1 to June 30.
- After the vaccination, complete the procedures for the rabies tag at an Administration Center or the Animal Protection Center. You may not complete these procedures at City Hall.
- You will need to bring the Rabies Vaccination Certificate from the animal clinic / hospital in order to receive the rabies tag.
- Some animal clinics / hospitals may also complete the procedures for the rabies tag on your behalf. Please confirm beforehand.
- The rabies tag will cost 550 yen.




Dog Walking Etiquette

- Always keep your dog on a short leash.
- Do not let your dog go off-leash.
- If possible, have your dog go to the bathroom at home.
- If you are taking a walk, please clean up after your dog so there is no waste or odor leftover.
- Pick up and take your dog's waste home with you.

② By Car If driving northbound to Yokohama, turn right at the Oppama Station intersection. Continue for about 1.8 km, past the Oppamashako-mae Bus Stop. The Animal Protection Center is next to Kaiyama Green Space, about 200 m from Recycle Center Aicle. (Located on the right-hand side of the road if driving away from Oppama Station.)
