Protect your family and home with fire alarms!

Every home is required to have residential fire alarms installed. Types of fire alarms include: smoke detectors and heat detectors. When a fire has broken out, the device will detect smoke or heat and sound an alarm. Simply installing a fire alarm saves lives!

There are two types of fire alarms:

Smoke Detectors and Heat Detectors



Smoke Detector

Will quickly alert you if a fire has broken out by detecting **smoke** and sounding an alarm.



Heat Detector

Will quickly alert you if a fire has broken out by detecting heat and sounding an alarm.



Smoke detectors will alert you quicker than heat detectors since smoke will reach the ceiling first in most cases when a fire breaks out.

Smoke detectors can be installed anywhere in the home. Heat detectors can only be installed in the kitchen.

To those with fire alarms already installed,

Test your alarm regularly!



- Press the test button to check if your alarm is working.
- The test method for each device may differ.
 Check the manufacturer's instructions for how to test your fire alarm.

Keep it clean!




- Use a dry towel to wipe away dust and keep your alarm clean.
- The cleaning method for each device may differ. Check the manufacturer's instructions for how to clean your fire alarm.
- Fire alarms and their batteries deteriorate after about 10 years.
 Replace alarms when they are about 10 years old.

To those who have not installed fire alarms,

Installing fire alarms will reduce property damage and death caused by fires.
 According to statistics by the Yokosuka Fire Bureau, complete/partial property loss by fire was reduced by about 80% and deaths were reduced by about 70%.
 It is urgent that you install fire alarms within your home if you have not done so already.

Where to Install Fire Alarms

- Kitchen (Ceiling or Wall)
- · Bedroom (Ceiling or Wall)
- If there is a bedroom on the second floor, install where the stairs are located.
 (Ceiling or Wall)



Install the fire alarm 1.5m away from the air conditioner vent.

Where to Buy Fire Alarms

 You can buy fire alarms at locations such as emergency supplies stores, electronics stores, and home centers.
