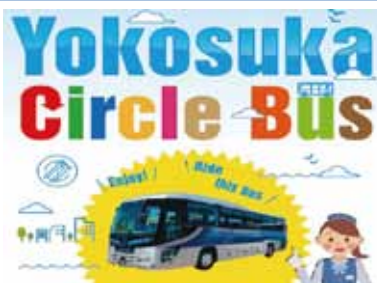


Oryo-san Festival
