Financial Support for Newly Married and Newly Sworn Partnership Oath Couples



Who is Eligible

1. Couples who were either married or swore a partnership oath sometime between January 2025 and February 2026.
2. Both partners must be 39 years of age or younger on the date of their marriage or partnership oath.
3. The combined total annual income of both partners must be less than ¥5,000,000.
4. Both partners must have the intention to continuously reside in Yokosuka for at least three years from the date of application.
5. Both partners must not be behind on their municipal resident tax payments.
6. Both partners must not be members of an organized crime group as defined in the “横須賀市暴力団排除条例 [Yokosuka City Ordinance on Elimination of Organized Crime Groups].”

What Expenses are Eligible

This financial support is granted based on housing-related expenses. Not all applicants may receive ¥300,000 or ¥600,000.

Expenses incurred for a new home (paid between April 2025 and February 2026)

1. Purchase price (not including land)
2. Housing rental expenses (including company housing, housing leased by your employer, and public housing)
3. Renovation expenses
4. Moving expenses

There are also other requirements. Please check the “結婚新生活支援事業 [Newly Married Support Program]” page on the Yokosuka city website (Japanese only). This page has “self-check” forms (Japanese only) to help you determine your eligibility. You can also come to the Planning and Coordination Division (details below) if you have questions.
