Who is Eligible

Couples must meet all of the following requirements

- 1 Couples who were married or swore a partnership oath sometime **between January 2026 and February 2027**.
- 2 Both partners must be **49 years of age or younger** on the date of their marriage or partnership oath.
- 3 The total combined annual taxable income of both partners must be **less than ¥5,000,000** (combined annual income of about ¥6,500,000).
- 4 Marriages involving foreign nationals must be registered with a municipal government office in Japan.
- 5 Both partners must intend to continue residing in Yokosuka for at least three years from the date of application. *Those who may not be able to reside in Japan for an extended period due to residence status, etc., may be ineligible.*
- 6 Both partners **must not be behind on municipal resident tax payments**.
- 7 Both partners **must not be members of an organized crime group** as defined in the “横須賀市暴力団排除条例(Yokosuka City Ordinance on Elimination of Organized Crime Groups).”
