



Yokosuka Zero-carbon City Declaration

The impacts of climate change are becoming apparent now more than ever. Extreme weather events are occurring around the world, and within each region of Japan, extreme heat and natural disasters caused by torrential rain are occurring more frequently.

It is predicted that there will be a rise in climate change risks such as extreme heat and torrential rain in the future due to increasing carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gas emissions that drive global warming. In order to mitigate these risks, each of us needs to heighten our awareness of the threat as the ones involved with climate change.

Under these circumstances, we hereby declare that Yokosuka City will enact an ordinance promoting the shift towards the realization of a decarbonized society and cooperate with citizens, citizens' organizations, and businesses to take action on preventing global warming so that we may achieve "net-zero carbon emissions by 2050."
