Medical Expense Assistance

(Partial assistance for medical expenses)

1. Advanced Elderly Medical Service System Health Insurance Division TEL 822-8272

Partial assistance for medical expenses for the Advanced Elderly Medical Service System for individuals age 65 or over.

2. Specific Intractable Disease Assistance Public Health Center Health Protection Division TEL 822-4385

Partial assistance for medical expenses for specific illnesses.

3. Specific Chronic Pediatric Disease Assistance Child Allowance Division TEL 822-9729

Partial assistance for medical expenses for specific childhood illnesses.

4. Assistance for Children

Child Allowance Division TEL 822-9729

Partial assistance for medical expenses for children who have been diagnosed with a specific illness which if neglected may cause future disability, for the purposes of eliminating or lessening said disability.

5. Assistance for Rehabilitation

Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8385

Partial assistance for individuals age 18 and over with a Physical Disability ID, for improvement of quality of life, lessening their impairment, and rehabilitation.

6. Assistance for Psychiatric Care Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8248 Partial Assistance for individuals undergoing psychiatric care. TEL 822-8248

7. Severe Disability Assistance

Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8385

Partial assistance for individuals that have been diagnosed as having a severe disability.

Pension, Allowance

(Conditions must be met to receive payments)

1. Disability Basic Pension Counter Service Division TEL 822-8235

If an individual was enrolled in the Japan National Pension at the time of their initial examination by a doctor for their illness or injury, they can apply for the Disability Basic Pension.

2. Disability Employees' Pension Pension Office TEL 827-1251

If an individual was enrolled in the Japan Employee's Pension at the time of their initial examination by a doctor for their illness or injury, they can apply for the Disability Employees' Pension.

3. Special Disability Allowance	
Disability Welfare Division	TEL 822-9488

Support for individuals 20 years or older who live at home that have a severe disability or mental disability which requires special assistance in daily life.

4. Disabled Child Welfare Allowance

Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-9488

Support for children under the age of 20 who have a severe physical or mental disability.

5. Kanagawa In-Home Severe Disability Allowance Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-9488

Support for individuals that live at home who have a severe disability that requires 24-hour care.

6. Yokosuka Severe Disability Welfare Allowance Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-9488

Support for individuals that live at home who have a severe disability.

7. Disability Support and Mutual Aid

Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-9488

Guardians who are looking after an individual with a disability provide regular monthly payments to this pension. Upon the guardian's own death or instance of acquiring a severe disability, the disabled person they are looking after will receive regular payments from this pension.

8. Severe Disability Caregiver Consolation Aid Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8385

Financial aid provided annually to caregivers who care for an individual with a severe disability.

9. Special Child Rearing Allowance Child Allowance Division TEL 822-9809

Support for individuals who are raising a child that is under the age of 20 and has a moderate to severe physical or mental disability.

10. Child Rearing Allowance

Child Allowance Division TEL 822-9809

Support for individuals who are raising a child that is under the age of 20 in a single-parent household.

Disability Welfare Services

1. Disability Welfare Services

Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8249

Support services based on the Services and Supports for Persons with Disabilities Act. Provides services to individuals according to the severity of their disability, daily activity, and residence status.

(Home care services, day services, residential services)

2. Community Life Support Services Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8249

Support services based on the Services and Supports for Persons with Disabilities Act. Determined by the local municipality's original ideas, provides a flexible range of services to individuals with disabilities based on their needs and social resources. (Transportation support, day support)

3. Other In-Home Support

Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-9488

The following in-home support is offered to individuals with disabilities:

- 1. In-Home Grooming Services
- 2. Washing of Bedding
- 3. In-Home Bathing Services
- 4. IT Instructor Dispatch (TEL 822-8249)



Prosthesis, Daily Living Aids, Etc.

(Conditions must be met to receive payments)

1. Financial Assistance System for Prosthetic Device Expenses Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8249

Items that are necessary for an individual with a physical disability to more easily live and work, such as hearing aids, glasses, wheelchairs, etc. are classified as prosthetic devices. This Financial Assistance System will partially cover the expenses of procuring and repairing prosthetic devices.

2. Financial Assistance System for Daily Living Aids Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-9488

Items that are necessary for an individual with a severe disability to function easily in their daily life, such as special beds, smoke detectors, talking clocks for the visually impaired, etc., are classified as daily living aids. This Financial Assistance System will partially cover the expenses of daily living aids.

3. Disposable Diaper Allowance

Support system for individuals with a disability who live at home that require disposable diapers.



Transport

(Conditions must be met to receive discounts and assistance)

1. Discounts for Public Transportation Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8248

When an individual presents their Disability ID they can receive discounts on public transportation.

- 1. Railway fare discounts
- 2. Bus fare discounts
- 3. Domestic airfare discounts
- 4. Taxi fare discounts
- 5. Ferry fare discounts
- 6. Toll road discounts

2. Financial Support for Automobiles, Etc. **Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8248**

- 1. Financial assistance for taxi fares (automobile fuel expenses)
- 2. Financial assistance for automobile driving lessons
- 3. Financial assistance for automobile modifications expenses

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Public Service Fees, Etc.

(Conditions must be met to receive fee reductions and discounts)

1. Water Supply and Sewerage Fee Reduction Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8248

Basic water supply and sewerage fees will be reduced for households with an individual who has a severe disability.

2. NHK License Fee Exemption Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8248

An individual will be exempt from paying the monthly NHK fee the month they submit an exemption form certified by the Welfare Division for Disabled Persons.

3. "Fureai Annai" (Free Telephone DirectoryAssistance) NTT EAST Fureai Annai TEL 0120-104174

Telephone directory assistance (#104) through "Fureai Annai" is offered for free.

4. Cell Phone Basic Usage Fee Discounts Cell phone provider stores, etc.

A discount on basic monthly cell phone usage and service fees. For further information, please contact a cell phone service provider.

5. Free Admission for Prefectural Cultural Centers

Relevant facilities

Individuals with a Disability ID will be exempt from paying fees when visiting prefectural cultural centers.

6. City Facility Usage Fee Reduction Disability Welfare Division TEL 822-8248

Fees will be reduced for individuals with a Disability ID when visiting city facilities.
