④ Implementation of Japanese language acquisition status assessment etc.

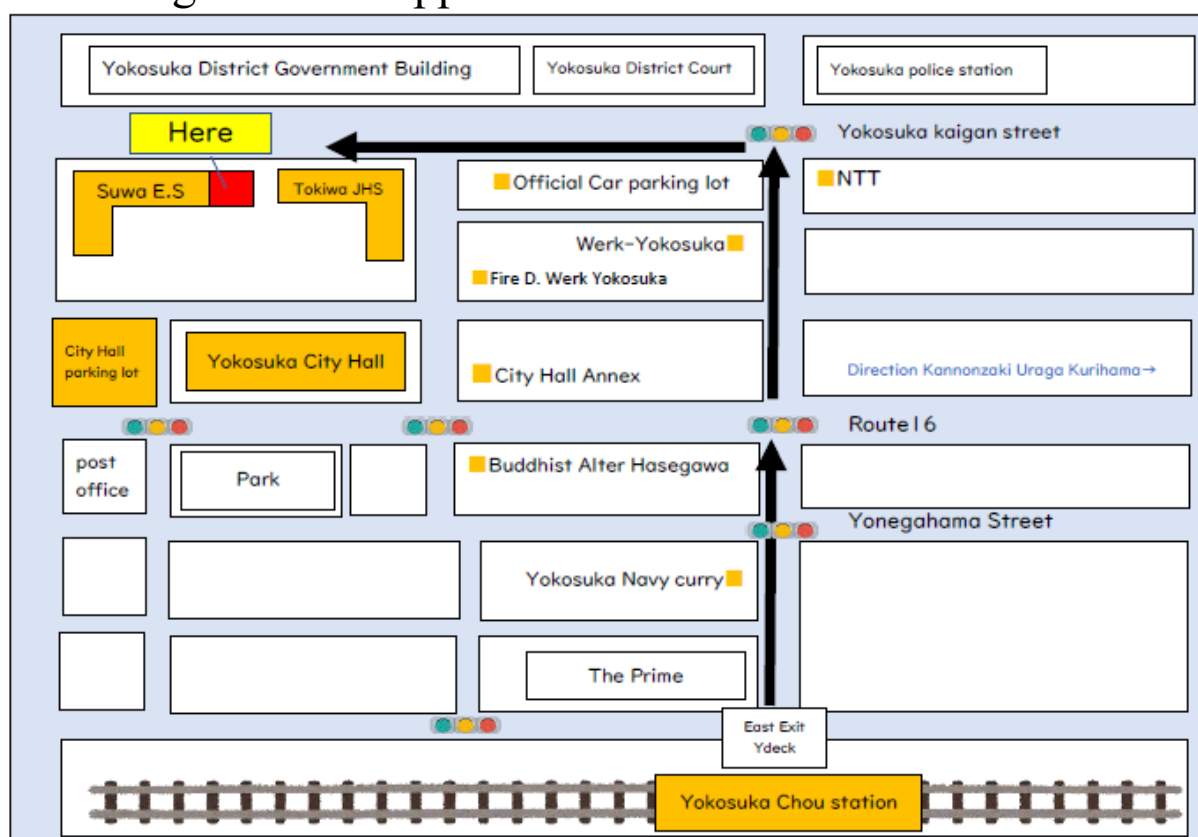

①A 10-minute walk from the East Exit of Yokosuka Chuo Station! After exiting the east exit of Chuo Station, go down the stairs on the right side of the front and go straight along the road (700m remaining)



②At the 3rd traffic light (when you see the police station) turn left and go straight. (170m remaining)
